This concert will be an engaging mix of traditional, modern and occasionally pithy seasonal music by composers spanning the 18th to 21st centuries

J.S. Bach's challenging motet *Singet dem Herrn ein neues Lied* combines passion and pyrotechnics in equal measure with spectacular writing for two competing choirs. **Pergolesi**'s *Magnificat* is light and frothy by comparison with bright melodies and fizzing rhythms; four of our talented and enthusiastic choir members will take the solos here.

There shall a star come out of Jacob by **Mendelssohn** is full of tuneful Advent promise, ending with the well-loved hymn "How brightly shines the morning star". If you know and love *Elijah*, you will hear plenty of similarities.

We will also be singing the very moving **Bethlehem Down** by **Warlock** and **Holst**'s **Lullay my Liking**, complemented by **Mack Wilberg**'s jolly setting of **Ding! Dong! merrily on high** and **Tavener**'s exquisite setting of **The Lamb**.

There will be plenty of well-known audience carols to be sung with gusto, all accompanied on the mighty Viscount Organ by the one and only Roger Briscoe.

Eager anticipation is in the air – we look forward to welcoming you.
